Accommodation

The 2013 OBSA Conference will be hosted by the Pacific Theological College, and will take place at its Jovili Meo Mission Centre. Accommodation is available for up to 28 people; preference will be given to Conference participants from outside Viti Levu.

The Centre was built less than 10 years ago and offers simple but comfortable rooms at inexpensive rates. For more information, please visit the JMMC web page on the PTC web site at http://ptc.ac.fj/wp/?page_id=95.

Please note that it is likely that you will be asked to share a room with another conference participant. Bathroom facilities are shared, and not ensuite. Only the conference rooms are air conditioned, but there are ceiling fans in all rooms.

We do not have credit card facilities. Please pay in cash (F\$).

1 Accommodation & Meals

- Accommodation per person per night is F\$40.
- Meals are: breakfast (F\$8); morning tea (F\$6); lunch (F\$10); afternoon tea (F\$6); dinner (F\$12).

As conference participants will arrive at different times, please calculate your costs accordingly, bearing in mind that **some meals are already included in the conference fee** (see below). The Conference begins on Thursday afternoon (1 August) and ends with dinner on Saturday evening (3 August).

2 Conference Fee

The Conference Fee is a flat fee of F\$75 and includes

- Welcome Feast on Thursday evening (1 August)
- Morning tea/coffee, lunch & afternoon tea/coffee on Friday & Saturday (2/3 August) as well as dinner on Saturday evening
